In an ordinary rural area, a group of aristocrats meets, in order to discuss about the social and political reality of their time, 1923: an era of political and ideological confusion. Before the strangers' arrival to the land, the neighbors had stated their loyalty to traditions; this gave birth to an ideological and cultural discrepancy that would cause endless and useless debates: they could have never come to an agreement, nor open their minds to new, different realities. This is a faithful portrait of that society in the early 20th century, which can help us to understand its socio-political ideology and to get close to those so protected costumes and traditions.

Antonio Mondragón Sánchez was born in 1959 in Zumárraga (Guipúzcoa). He's the author of two more published novels: *Gambeto* y *Nuevo Amanecer*. He's interested in deepening historical processes, and he's willing to realize more works of any genre.

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
