

Enlai, the Warrior of Light | Mónica Pardo Redondo

A long reflection about what it's like to be a woman through the history of Enlai's family, that begins at the end of 20th century and develops until the present. The protagonist of this intimate diary is living a difficult relationship with her family. An aggressive father, a manipulative mother and an ill sister are some of the causes of her deep depression. When she loses her job, she shows a surprising inner strength, the same as her heroes, the “warriors of light”, fighters who don't give up and who only know the energy of love. Once grown up, her last challenge is a new vision of life: she'll finally heal her wounds, educating her children following the values she believes in.

Mónica Pardo Redondo is a 45 year old single mother of two. She's a union official. This is her first work, with the aim of being an inspiration for other people.
